- > \$75 USD application fee
- Secondary transcripts/mark sheets
- Transfer applicants need to provide post-secondary transcripts/mark sheets from every post-secondary institution attended
- ► Evidence of English language proficiency
- International Admissions may require additional documents depending upon your individual situation

- \$75 USD application fee
- Complete post-secondary transcripts/mark sheets with proof of graduation
- Official GRE/GMAT scores per program requirements
